### **Doringkloof Neighbourhood Watch**

The DNW is rolling out a “Festive Season Safety Plan 2018” which has already commenced with a document called “Holiday tips”.

The primary objective of this initiative is to make Doringkloof a safe place for residents and visitors during the 2018 festive season and until schools re-open on 09 January 2019. The plan will run from 15<sup>th</sup> November until 11<sup>th</sup> January, with regular high-visibility patrols, scheduled patrols and ad-hoc patrols.

State name, address, period away from home, and provide a contact number of whoever will be looking after the property. It may be advisable to include an authority for DNW members to enter the property if a crime occurs, especially if a contact number is likely to be unreachable.

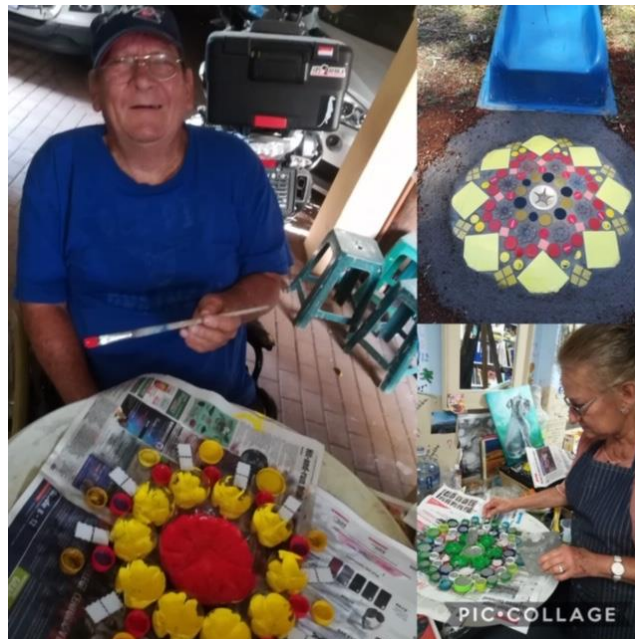
