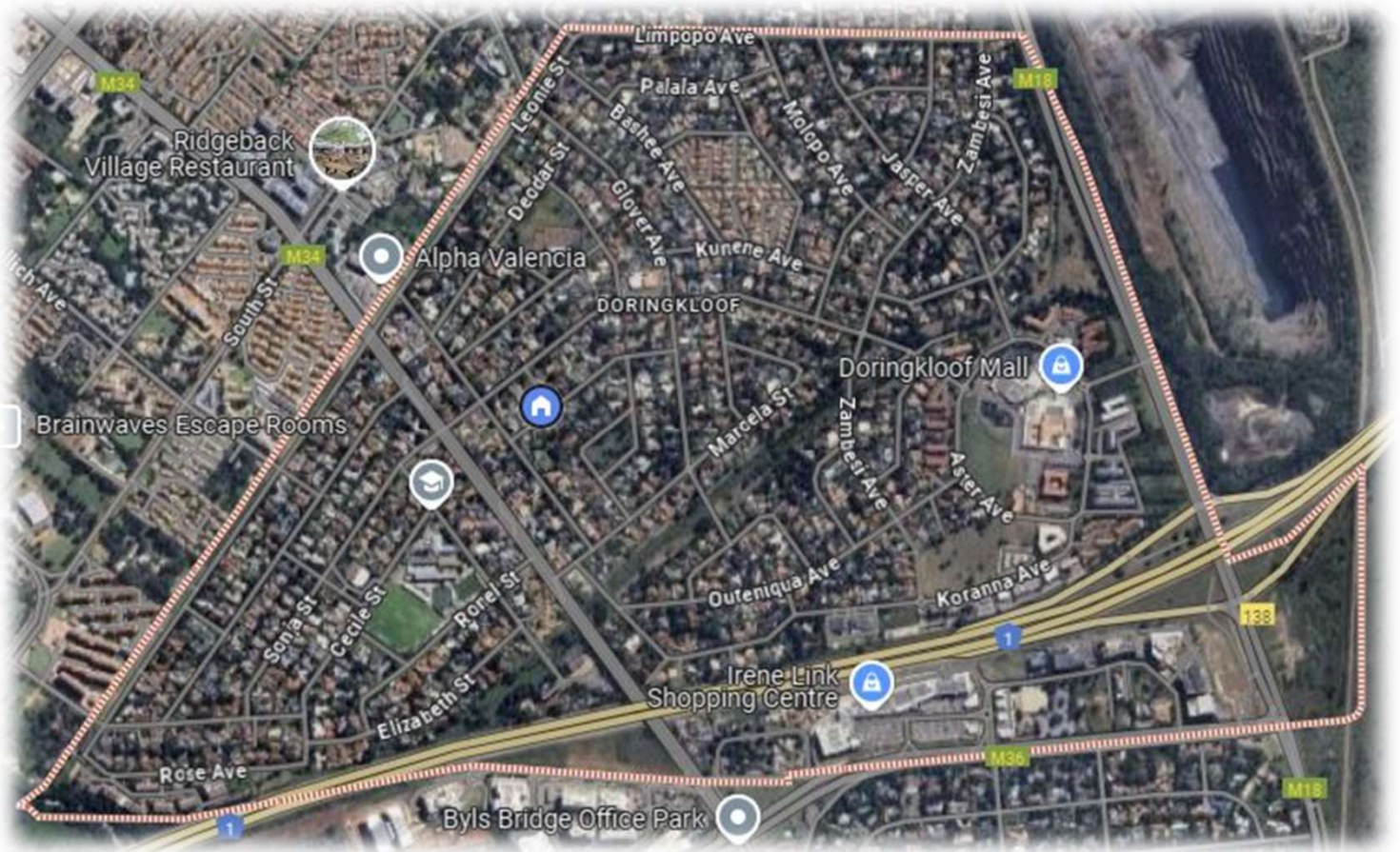


The Heart of Doringkloof

- In the next few pages, we want to try and share the heart of our community with you.

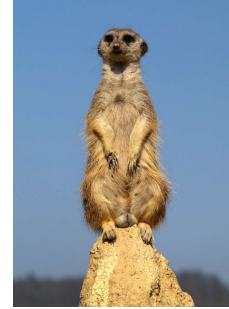


Map of Doringkloof

- Self-guided tree information walk

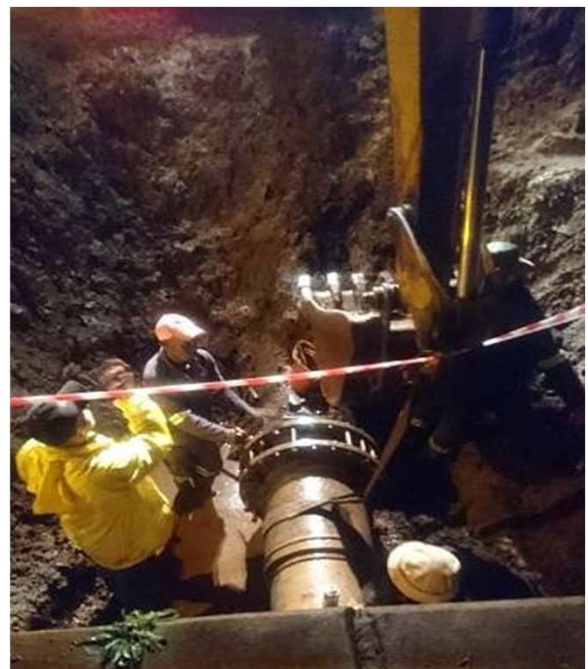
